

NYLT — NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING

- NYLT is the Boy Scouts of America's premier youth leadership development program.
- NYLT is designed to train all the youth leaders of a Troop with leadership skills they will be able to apply in Scouting and throughout the rest of their life.



WHAT IS IT?

Six-day course that is delivered in a troop and patrol outdoor setting with an emphasis on immediate application of learning in a fun environment.

Interconnecting concepts and work processes are introduced early, built upon, and aided by the use of memory aids, which allows participants to understand and employ the leadership skills much faster.

The NYLT course centers around the concepts of what a leader must BE, what a leader must KNOW, and what a leader must DO.

The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on HOW TO.

The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership.

This training is at the council level and only occurs only 1x per year
